### **EXHIBITION HALL RULES & REGULATIONS**

Entries must be brought in to the 4-H Building between 4-7 pm, Wednesday, August 2rd and must be picked up between 6-7 pm, Monday, August 7th.

- 1. Only one entry per class.
- 2. Entries must be made by exhibitor within the past 12 months.
- 3. No item may be entered that has been exhibited in any previous year.
- 4. SWEEPSTAKES AWARD: One award per age group, based on the total number of points.
- 5. Entries will be judged on creativity, use of materials, neatness, and age of exhibitor.
- 6. Entries without competition will be judged on merit to the discretion of the judge in each department.
- 7. Exhibits that could be entered in more than one division will be placed at the discretion of the judge.
- 8. Judges and/or superintendents may disqualify an item.
- 9. Judges may award a Best in Show ribbon.
- 10. All decisions by the judges will be final.
- 11. The 4-H Building is open daily from 8 AM to 8 PM.
- 12. Each exhibitor will be entitled to receive (1) one free one day child pass. Additional passes may be purchased at a discount. Vouchers to purchase passes are obtainable from each department superintendent.
- 13. The exhibitor will furnish all containers. The Cheshire Fair Association will not be responsible for loss or damage of containers, so please do not use valuable containers.

- 14. The exhibitor must name all entries. Entry Form below or available, along with Exhibit Tags, at the Fair Office.
- 15. The Cheshire Fair Association will not be responsible for any accident or damage that may occur to persons or property while on the fairgrounds or on the road leading to the fairgrounds.
- 16. Entries must remain for exhibit for the duration of the Fair. Any unauthorized removal of an exhibit will result in loss of premiums. See individual departments for times that exhibits may be picked up.
- 17. Prize money and ribbons not claimed by designated pickup time are forfeited. Items not picked up will be donated to a local charity.
- 18. The Cheshire Fair Association reserves the right to prorate or defer premium payments, if necessary, should funds not be available to grant immediate payment.
- 19. Any knowing violation of these rules and the rules of each department will disqualify the exhibitor from premium awards.
