A Silage Corn (2 full stocks and ears, roots tied in grain bag)

1. Hybrid- under 95 days, 2000 D.D.
2. Hybrid- over 95 days, not over 2500

D.D. B Hay (eight-inch bale slice)

1. First cutting-legume grasses
2. First cutting-mixed or straight grasses
3. Haylage – second cutting legume grass
4. Second cutting-mixed or straight grasses
5. Haylage-legume or grass, 2023 crop
6. Corn Silage, 2021 Crop

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits must be at the forage exhibit location by 5pm, Wednesday, August 2, 2023
2. Exhibits should be marked by exhibitor as to class.
3. All varieties will be accepted if properly marked and identified. Superintendent reserves the right to place variety in another class if it is incorrectly identified or not marked completely.
4. Ribbons will be displayed on exhibit throughout the fair.
5. Exhibitors will receive ribbons and premiums through the mail after the fair.
6. Each exhibitor is permitted one entry per class. With exception of Class 5 & 6, all entries must be produced on exhibitor's farm in 2022.
7. Silage corn entries must be identified by name and variety.
8. Haylage should be exhibited in one-gallon largemouth jar.
9. Sweepstakes award is for greatest variety of good forage from one farm. One exhibitor must have entered exhibits in Class A & B.
