**Premiums:** Exhibits will be judged using the Danish System. Points are awarded by the judge based on the following:

White Ribbon 35	c. Quality of exhibit	20 points	
Best Exhibit Rosette & \$100	d. Exhibit meets requirements	20 points

	f. Incorporating Cheshire Fair theme to exhibit "Blue Jeans and Country Dreams"	10 points

### Rules & Regulations

1. All Granges are invited to compete.
2. Exhibits must be in placed in the 4-H building between 3-6pm on Wednesday, August 2 and **must** be picked up between 3-6 pm on Monday, August 7, 2023.
3. Exhibit space is 8 ft. long, 33 inches high, and 30 inches deep.
4. Space must be reserved by calling the Superintendent no later than July 22.
5. Score sheets may be obtained after the Fair or may be mailed out.

### EXHIBITION HALL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The 4-H building is open daily from 8am to 8pm.
2. All exhibitors are entitled to purchase 1 (one) pass per department entered at a discount. Vouchers to purchase passes are obtainable from each department superintendent.
3. The Cheshire Fair Association will not be responsible for loss or damage of items.
4. All decisions by the judges will be final.
5. The Cheshire Fair Association will be responsible for any accident or damage that may occur to persons or property while on the fairgrounds or on the road leading to the fairgrounds.
6. Entries must remain for exhibit for the duration of the Fair. Any unauthorized removal of an exhibit will result in loss of premiums.
7. Prize money and ribbons not claimed by designate pickup times are forfeited. Items not picked up will be donated to a local charity.
8. The Cheshire Fair Association reserves the right to probate or defer premium payments, if necessary, should funds not be available to grant immediate payment.
9. Any knowing violation of these rules and the rules of each department will disqualify the exhibitor from premium awards.
